Grading Policy

- Daily assignments are due by 3 pm each day. If you need extra time, please contact me through ClassDojo or email.
- Assignments must be completed. The teacher will send incomplete work back to the student so he/she can finish it.
- Assignments will be graded according to the standard based criteria:
 - 4 Advanced (90-100%; mastered it)
 - 3 Proficient (70-89%; understands it)
 - 2 Basic (60-69%; needs more practice)
 - 1 Below Basic (59% or less; needs help)

Attendance



Assignments


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Daily assignments will be posted weekly in Google Classroom.




Home Support: Parents, Please make sure...

- 1.Please make sure your child has a quiet place to do his/her work. A desk or table is ideal. A chair is important for your child's posture and back. An environment without distractions is ideal.
- 2.Please make sure your child has all school supplies in one place. This includes all workbooks, paper, pencils, markers, and charger for the laptop.
- 3.Please make sure your child's laptop is charged or plugged in so that the energy doesn't run out in the middle of class.
- 4.Please have your child wake up, eat breakfast, and use the restroom before class starts at 8:30 am. He/she will be able to use the restroom during independent work time, after teacher instruction.
- 5.Please check to see that your child has completed each day's assignments. Once his/her assignments are done, then he/she is done for the day. Rewards are encouraged, such as time for online games, playing outside, watching TV, etc...


