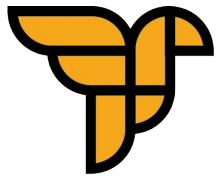

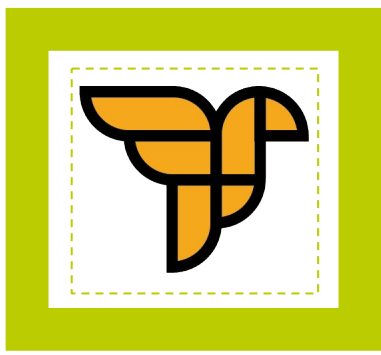
Please be on time to Zoom meets.

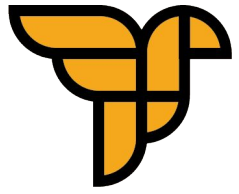


# Grading Policy

Students are able to continue to show mastery. Mistakes will be embraced as learning opportunities. Grades will be a both a reflection of effort and various assessments. More details to come.



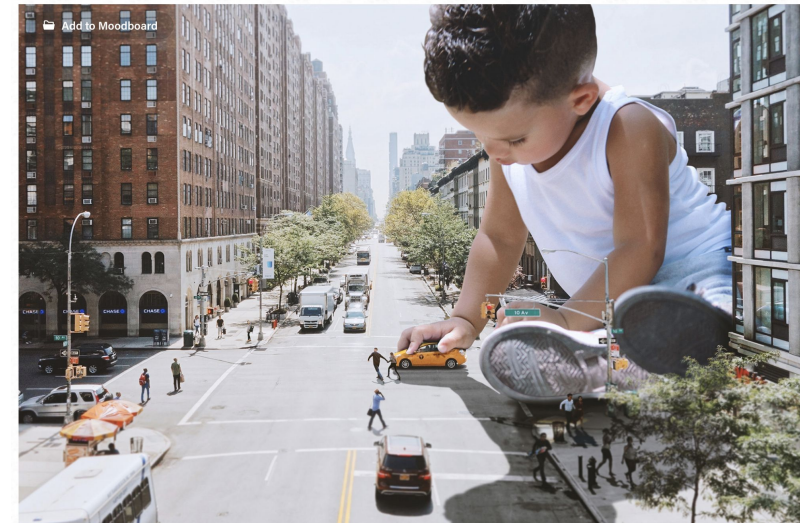
# What we will study this first month...
